Swedish Relaxation—This European massages applies varied hand-work to promote relaxation. This massage can be slow to vigorous depending on the desired results.

Detoxifying Tranquility Wrap—\$110

Heated oils, herbs and essential oils are applied to the dry brushed skin. You are then wrapped in layered heated blankets and plastic, cocoon style, to begin the detoxification process. A finishing massage leaves you totally relaxed and cleansed.

Elisi Signature Exfoliation—\$120

A customized body scrub over your entire body increases circulation and smooths the skin. The scrub is removed with warm towels and your treatment is completed with a hot lotion massage. Heavenly!

Muskwa Mud Wrap—\$120

Custom blended mud is combined with essential oils, herbs and plants and is applied to the skin warmed. You are wrapped and left to relax while your skin is treated to a sumptuous and nutritious experience. Once removed a finishing massage is received.
